THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WEST SUSSEX (VARIOUS PARISHES: SOUTH DOWNS WAY (PART) AND ADJOINING RUAPPS) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER, 1989

The County Council of West Sussex in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) and (2) and 22 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-first day of August 1989, and may be cited as "The County Council of West Sussex (Various Parishes: South Downs Way (Part) and Adjoining RUAPPs) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1989."
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle (except pedal cycles) on the lengths of Roads used as Public Paths (referred to in this Order as "RUAPPS") specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of RUAPPs referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to those lengths of RUAPPS, or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land; or
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to those lengths of RUAPPs, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in those lengths of RUAPPs, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of those lengths of RUAPPs, or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to those lengths of RUAPPs of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications; or
 - (c) in an emergency for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of RUAPPs referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used to gain access to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of RUAPPs.


