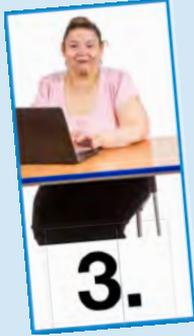

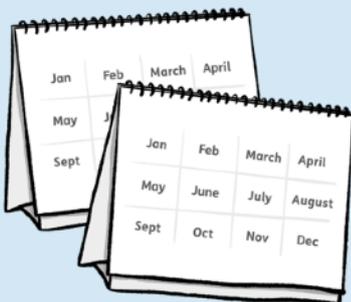

A **referee** is someone that can tell us about you and what you are like. They should not be a member of your family.

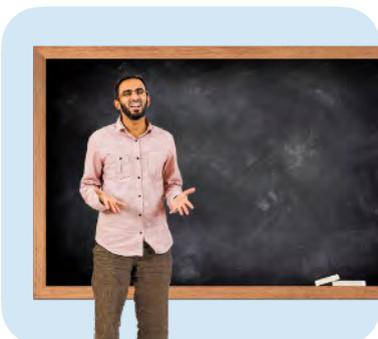


A referee could be:

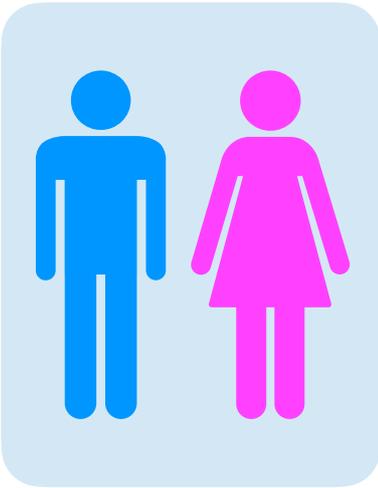
