## West Sussex County Council (East Grinstead: Turners Hill Road (B2110)) (Restricted Road and Consolidation) Order 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 30 MPH speed limit on Turners Hill Road (B2110) in East Grinstead, from its junction with Hurst Farm Road, southwestwards for 280 metres.

The Order also re-enacts the 40 MPH speed limit from the end of the new 30 MPH Speed Limit, southwestwards to the existing terminal point 175m southwest of Imberhorne Lane.

## West Sussex County Council (East Grinstead: Turners Hill Road (B2110)) (Restricted Road and Consolidation) Order 2024

#### Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce a 30 MPH speed limit on Turners Hill Road (B2110) in East Grinstead, from its junction with Hurst Farm Road, southwestwards for 280 metres.

The Council has received an application requesting a 30 MPH speed limit on Turners Hill Road to cover the junction with Butlers Way, which provides access to a new housing development on the northern side of Turners Hill Road.

This application has been assessed against the West Sussex County Council speed limit policy, which sets criteria for new speed limits by considering current traffic speeds, the safety history of the road and the use of the road by vulnerable road users such as cyclists, pedestrians and equestrians. The affected length of road complies with the criteria set for a 30 MPH speed limit and the new Order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The Order also re-enacts the 40 MPH speed limit from the end of the new 30 MPH Speed Limit, southwestwards to the existing terminal point 175m southwest of Imberhorne Lane.

The attached drawing, numbered MDS2403 show the length of road affected by the proposed order.

# WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (EAST GRINSTEAD: TURNERS HILL ROAD (B2110)) (RESTRICTED ROAD AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2024

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the \*\*\*\*\* day of \*\*\*\*\*\* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (East Grinstead: Turners Hill Road (B2110) (Restricted Road and Consolidation) Order 2024"
- 2. The Order Specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. The length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 Miles Per Hour in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Paragraphs 3 or 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
  - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
  - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
    - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
    - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
