## WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (PETWORTH: A272, A283 & VARIOUS ROADS) (20MPH, 30MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

**NOTICE** is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to introduce a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce:-

- (i) a 20mph speed limit on lengths of A272 Pound Street, A283 Angel Street, A283 Church Street, A283 East Street, A283 Market Square, A283 New Street, A283 North Street, A283 Park Road, A283 Saddlers Row, Barton Lane, Damers Bridge, Grove Street, High Street, Lombard Street, Middle Street, Orchard Close, Rosemary Lane, Sheepdown Close and Sheepdown Drive; and
- (ii) a 30mph speed limit on a length of A283 Angel Street; and
- (iii) a 50mph speed limit on a length of A283 London Road

## WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (PETWORTH: A272, A283 & VARIOUS ROADS) (20MPH, 30MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

#### Statement of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order, the effect of which will be to introduce:-

- (i) a 20mph speed limit on lengths of A272 Pound Street, A283 Angel Street, A283 Church Street, A283 East Street, A283 Market Square, A283 New Street, A283 North Street, A283 Park Road, A283 Saddlers Row, Barton Lane, Damers Bridge, Grove Street, High Street, Lombard Street, Middle Street, Orchard Close, Rosemary Lane, Sheepdown Close and Sheepdown Drive; and
- (ii) a 30mph speed limit on a length of A283 Angel Street; and
- (iii) a 50mph speed limit on a length of A283 London Road

The Town Council submitted a community highway scheme application for a 20mph speed limit in Petworth. The 20mph speed limit will apply on roads within Petworth village centre.

The schemes aims to improve road safety in Petworth and reduce both air and noise pollution on the busy 'A' road routes through the town and in the town centre.

To avoid the speed limit changing from national to 20mph the scheme has been designed with a 30mph buffer zone on the A283 Angel Street westbound approach to the village. This buffer zone will allow drivers more deceleration time and slow vehicular traffic before they reach the 20mph village speed limit. This together with repeater signs and roundels aims to improve compliance with the new speed limits and the effectiveness of the scheme.

There will also be a 50mph buffer on the A283 London Road southbound approach to the village.

This Order is proposed so as to reduce danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Drawing CHI2403 Petworth Proposed Speed Limit (08.05.2024) shows the lengths of roads, which are the subject of the proposed order.

## WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (PETWORTH: A272, A283 & VARIOUS ROADS) (20MPH, 30MPH AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202\*

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 (2), 83 (2) and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the X day of X 202\* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Petworth: A272, A283 & Various Roads) (20mph, 30mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2023"
- 2. The Orders in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
- 3. The lengths of restricted roads in the Second Schedule to this Order shall cease to be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 6. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
- 7. Nothing in Paragraphs 4,5 and 6 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
  - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
  - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
    - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
    - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
