(Shoreham-By-Sea: Upper Shoreham Road and Middle Road Amendment) Order 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) at the junction of Upper Shoreham Road with The Drive in Shoreham-By-Sea and extends the existing double yellow lines on the southern side of Upper Shoreham Road at its eastern junction with Buckingham Road. The Order also extends lengths of existing double yellow lines on Middle Road.

<u>Shoreham-By-Sea: Upper Shoreham Road – Pedestrian and Cyclists Crossing Place</u>

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to install a zebra crossing on Upper Shoreham Road in Shoreham-By-Sea located at the site of an existing traffic island between the two arms of its junction with Buckingham Road. The crossing would be of a dual use design to facilitate crossing by pedestrians and cyclists, linking new cycle lanes on Buckingham Road and The Drive.

Shoreham-By-Sea: Buckingham Road and The Drive: Traffic Calming Features

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to install raised traffic calming features on both arms of Buckingham Road at its junction with Upper Shoreham Road, and on The Drive at its junction with Upper Shoreham Road. In addition to providing traffic calming, these features will provide crossing points for a new shared use pedestrian/cycle route being installed at the affected junctions.

The proposed features will be constructed in black macadam with a height of 65mm and ramps of 0.7m in length.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the <u>West Sussex County Council website</u>. The website includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce double yellow lines at the junction of Upper Shoreham Road with The Drive in Shoreham-By-Sea and extend the existing double yellow lines on the southern side of Upper Shoreham Road at its eastern junction with Buckingham Road. The Order also extends lengths of existing double yellow lines on Middle Road.

<u>Shoreham-By-Sea: Upper Shoreham Road - Pedestrian and Cyclists Crossing</u> Place

West Sussex County Council proposes to install a zebra crossing on Upper Shoreham Road in Shoreham-By-Sea located at the site of an existing traffic island between the two arms of its junction with Buckingham Road. The crossing would be of a dual use design to facilitate crossing by pedestrians and cyclists, linking new cycle lanes on Buckingham Road and The Drive.

Shoreham-By-Sea: Buckingham Road and The Drive: Traffic Calming Features

West Sussex County Council proposes to install raised traffic calming features on both arms of Buckingham Road at its junction with Upper Shoreham Road, and on The Drive at its junction with Upper Shoreham Road.

The proposed waiting restrictions, zebra crossing and traffic calming features described above are all part of a larger scheme to provide better, safer access for pedestrians and cyclists travelling across Upper Shoreham Road. The project includes the installation of new cycle lanes on Buckingham Road with access to The Drive provided by the new zebra crossing, which will have a section for pedestrians and a separate parallel section for cyclists. Traffic calming features on Buckingham Road and The Drive will provide a level area for pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road while also reducing traffic speed. To accommodate the new arrangements safely, additional double yellow lines are proposed to ensure visibility at the junctions and crossing are not obstructed.

In addition to the project at the junction above it is proposed to improve cycle access along Middle Road by providing cycle bypass lanes through the existing buildout features. This requires minor adjustments to the length of double yellow lines at the buildouts to ensure safe access.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ2105NEN, TQ2205SEN and TQ2305SWN show the proposed waiting restrictions. Further drawings are attached to show the layout of the proposed crossing and traffic calming features.


