NOTICE is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which originally came into force on 15 January 2024, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 14 September 2025 or until the works are completed.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst ongoing development works are undertaken in the vicinity. The route remains unsafe for the public due to the presence of machinery, scaffolding and drainage trenches.

The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 795_2 Loxwood, from its western end at its junction with Public Bridleway No. 810 (TQ036316), eastwards to its junction with Rowner Road (TQ038317), a distance of approximately 195 metres.
