## WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (RUSPER: PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 1492) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2023

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Order made by West Sussex County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and which originally came into force on 18 September 2023, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, will now continue in force until 18 September 2026.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety due to the partial loss and erosion of the path into the adjacent watercourse. Further landslips and erosion have resulted in additional deterioration of the path and surrounding woodland. Drainage improvement works are necessary to stabilise the adjoining land. Until these are approved and completed the path remains unsafe for use and needs to remain closed.


The effect of the Order remains unchanged and is to prohibit any person from proceeding along a length of Public Footpath No. 1492 Rusper, from its junction with Friday Street (TQ185369), eastwards to its junction with High Street (TQ205373), a distance of approximately 2.3 kilometres.

Unfortunately, there is no alternative routes available using the Public Rights of Way network.
