(Haywards Heath: Gander Hill and Sunnywood Drive Amendment) Order 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) throughout the northern side of Gander Hill in Haywards Heath between its junctions with Sunte Close and Gander Green. The Order also installs a single yellow line prohibiting waiting 9am to 10am and 1pm to 2pm Mon-Fri on the southern side of Gander Hill on the currently unrestricted length of road east of Summerhill Close.

The Order also makes a short reduction to the length of existing double yellow lines on the eastern side of Sunnywood Drive, opposite its junction with Drummond Close.

Full details of the proposals in this notice can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the <u>West Sussex County Council website</u>. The website includes a response form for any comments or objections.

(Haywards Heath: Gander Hill and Sunnywood Drive Amendment) Order 2025

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce double yellow lines throughout the northern side of Gander Hill in Haywards Heath between its junctions with Sunte Close and Gander Green. The Order also installs a single yellow line prohibiting waiting 9am to 10am and 1pm to 2pm Mon-Fri on the southern side of Gander Hill on the currently unrestricted length of road east of Summerhill Close.

West Sussex County Council has received an application to review parking arrangements on Gander Hill from residents concerned that current parking arrangements make access to driveways difficult and that parking on the northern side of the road often takes place half on the pavement, obstructing pedestrians and causing congestion for traffic.

The proposed restrictions are intended to resolve these issues by ensuring the northern side of the road is kept clear of parked vehicles. The single yellow line east of Summerhill Close is proposed to prevent the remaining parking areas on the road being monopolised by long staying vehicles.

The Order also makes a short reduction to the length of existing double yellow lines on the eastern side of Sunnywood Drive, opposite its junction with Drummond Close. The current length of double yellow line prevents a nearby resident from parking on the crossover leading to their garage. On review it is accepted that parking at this location causes no safety or obstruction issues, so the restriction is being amended on the grounds that it is unnecessary.

The new restrictions proposed by this order are therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ3325SES and TQ3325SWS show the restrictions proposed on Gander Hill. Drawing Number TQ 3223SEN shows the amended restriction on Sunnywood Drive.








