NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to introduce a permanent Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to reduce the speed limit from 60mph to 30mph on the A259 Cathedral Way.

<u>WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL</u> (CHICHESTER: A259 CATHEDRAL WAY & ADJOINING ROADS) (RESTRICTED ROAD & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2025

Statement Of Reasons For Proposing To Make The Order

The County Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make a permanent Order the effect of which will be to reduce the speed limit from 60mph to 30mph on the A259 Cathedral Way.

The A259 Cathedral Way is a street lit road that is currently de-restricted by Traffic Order and has a speed limit of 60mph. This section of road has been identified as a site with a high collision rate, particularly around the southbound, right turn into Fishbourne Road East.

To improve safety for vehicles turning at the junction of Cathedral Way and Fishbourne Road East it is proposed to reduce the speed limit to 30mph. It is proposed to revoke the de-restriction Order. Cathedral Way will then become a restricted road by virtue of street lighting and subject to a 30mph speed limit.

The proposed reduction in speed limit forms part of a package of road safety improvements to reduce the risk of collisions. This includes vegetation clearance, replacement of traffic signage and increasing driver inter-visibility by the replacement of sections of verge with hard landscaping.

The reduced speed limit has been assessed to ensure conformity with the WSCC Speed Limit Policy. The objective of the assessment is to achieve a balance between providing reasonable consistency of speed limit along a route and the need to encourage awareness of lower speed limits where risks are higher.

The opportunity is being taken to consolidate the existing 40mph speed limit on the A259 Via Ravenna into this Order.

This Order is proposed so as to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or to minimise the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the safe passage of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82 (2) 83(2) and 84 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the X Day of x 202* and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Chichester: A259 Cathedral Way & Adjoining Roads) (Restricted Road & 40mph Speed Limit Consolidation) Order 2025"
- 2. The Orders in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. The lengths of roads in the Second Schedule to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 82 of the Act.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 6. Nothing in Paragraphs 4 and 5 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-

(i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or

(ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

2.	A259 Via Ravenna	From its junction with Westgate Link Roundabout junction eastwards for a distance of 25 metres.
3.	A259 Westgate Link	The entire length.

THIRD SCHEDULE 40mph Speed Limit

Length of road in Chichester

Roundabout

1. A259 Via Ravenna From a point 100 metres west of the Via Ravenna Roundabout junction westwards to a point 25 metres east of the Westgate Link Roundabout junction.
